Partners: Public Works will follow in 1-1.5 years - strenghtening the north end, making the path ADA-compliant, adding a water connection, reconfiguring the Minn/25th corner and improving crosswalks there and at 24th St. The adjacent property owner is working with GBD to meet his needs and improve the area.

Funding: Donations total \$40,000 to date. A \$5,000 matching grant has been pledged in addition. Since this is the only major project still moving forward in 19/20, the GBD has the option to place remaining Capital funds for 19/20 towards completing this project.

Related Projects: The Minnesota Street Project plans to add a sidewalk and street trees across Minn St. from the Grove. The plans are under City review.

Genesis: Requested by neighbors

Description: The project has two parts or phases: 1. Create a pedestrian path of travel on 20th between Indiana and Tennessee, including safer crosswalks. 2. Improve the areas under the 20th St overpass. There are no sidewalks parallel to the 20th St overpass on a street that connects hundreds of units of new housing on Indiana, Esprit Park, La Scuola and, further east, the T Line, the AIC and the waterfront. Neighbors have also pressed for improvements to the areas under the overpass, which are dark and have attracted numerous negative uses.

Partners: Amazon: Amazon's distribution center has axacerbated problems on 20th. We are working with them to reconfigure their onsite space, pave that block of 20th, add sidewalks on 20th and Minnesosta, configure their parking to drivers respect the one way street, and contain their garbage.

RecPark: Changes to the portion of 20th addjacent to Esprit could possibly be made as part of the Esprit renovation.

SF Planning Dept/Public Works: IPIC and other funding may be available for City staff work on the project.

Funding: The GBD's primary contribution to the project has been concept studies, by Nelson Nygaard for pedestrian planning. We budgeted funds in 19/20 for Fletcher Studio to do some rough intial concepts for the under overpass portion of the project. That can roll over or be rebudgeted in 20/21

Description: The City planned to fence 6,000 square feet under the 18th overpass at Indiana and use it for storage. The UCSF Tidelands project opened up pedestsrian paths on either side of the space and UCSF supports renovation. But Neighbors did not select USOP as a cushiniong funds site and UCSF ran into opposition from the City when they approached them about converting the space. The GBD has since recieved permission to submit a proposal for public access to/use of the space. Renovation would improve the new pedestrian link along the 18th St ROW between Minnesota and Indiana and help to make Indiana more pedestrian friendly, linking Mariposa Park, the Dogpatch Arts Plaza, Esprit Park and Woods Yard Park. The GBD funded a concept design by the Tidelands landscape designer, SURFACEDESIGN.

Partners: UCSF: We have asked that UCSF provide funding, security for the space and assistance with its maintenance.

Public Works: Available funds could be used by Public Works to supply lighting and electrical to the space.

Funding: Surplus funding available from Public Works and from the UCSF grant for the Caltrain station have been reallocated to this project. The Tidelands contractor has offerd some cash and pro bono assistance. The project may be a candidate for CCG funding.
