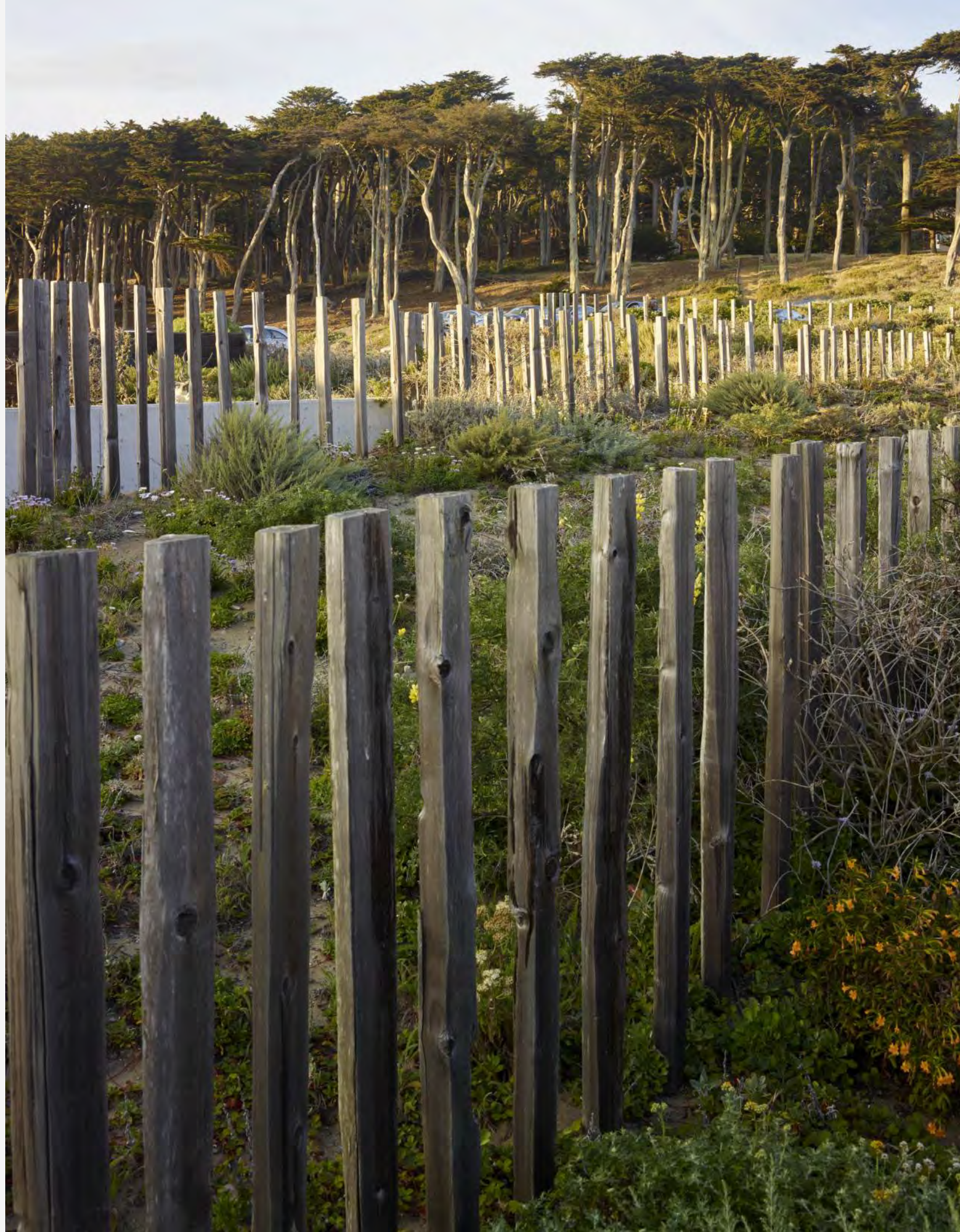

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Material Precedents



- 1 Reclaimed Concrete slab as Walls
- 2 Reclaimed Concrete slab as seating
- 3 Reclaimed Granite Curbs (Currently some in 18"x36" dimensions available)
- 4 Reclaimed granite curb/field stone as wall/bench
- 5,6 Reclaimed Concrete slab as pavers / Reclaimed logs as benches
- 7 Reclaimed San Francisco Cobble (Currently available)
- 8 Sonoma Field Stone (Currently available)

Planting Palette



The Planting palette is composed of native, drought tolerant species similar to other projects recently completed by the Dogpatch & NW Potrero Hill Benefit District and expands on work previously completed by the Eco Patch project. Grasses and shrubs will act as foundational planting with a mix of perennials providing seasonal color and additional texture. In addition to providing improved visual interest, the new planting design will also expand habitat for various pollinators and other small wildlife species in the neighborhood as well as learning and engagement opportunities for the community.
